For the love of cats



If you're a cat owner, chances are that you've been worried that your beloved cat finds the vet experience horribly stressful. Not only because he's ill or injured, or even just waiting for their annual health assessment, and about to see the vet, but because, for cats, the vet practice can be a terrifying place. The cacophony of canine noise, barking, whining and clawing, can send a cat's cortisol stress hormones soaring through the roof. That's why many cat owners resist taking their beloved cat to the vets in the first place, preferring to see if they get better, rather than putting their poor puss through such a stressful ordeal. That approach is clearly not in the cat's best interests.

As a response to these concerns we decided a few months ago to organise a cat-only clinic every Wednesday from 2pm to 3pm. Our practice is quiet,

and we release a synthetic calming pheromone into the air. This is the same as the pheromone that cats release from the glands around their mouth, neck and

tail when they are 'bunting' or rubbing up against objects that mark their home territory. It sends the olfactory signal that 'there is no need to be anxious, this place is fine'.

Some of our veterinary nurses and veterinary surgeons are passionate about cats and dedicate part of their career to learn about them and provide expert medical care to felines. Our highly-trained, caring nurses are cat lovers and owners; nurses who understand their patients are unique and need sensitive handling.
